Jon was also nominated for Employee of the Month by his amputee patients.

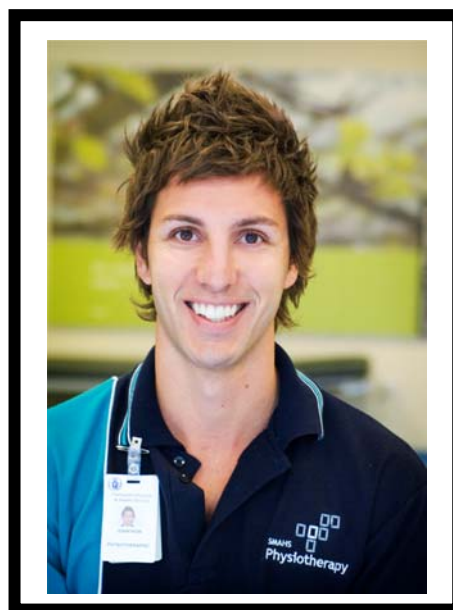
They said in their submissions that Jon was "doing a wonderful job .. and has a wonderful rapport and excellent communication skills."
