The Fremantle Heart Patients Support Group (FHPSG) has celebrated its 21st Anniversary at a function in the Fremantle Town Hall.

About 100 members, all of whom have had heart surgery, gathered to hear addresses from Dr John O'Shea (cardiologist), Peter Tagliaferri (the Patron of the group, and Mayor of Fremantle), Professor Michael Quinlan (Chancellor of the Notre Dame University Australia, Fremantle), Dr Graeme Dedman (Fremantle Hospital) and Joyce Mynett (president of the FHPSG).

A special presentation to Hugh Jones was made during the function. Mr Jones was the driving force behind the formation of the group and has had an active involvement ever since.
